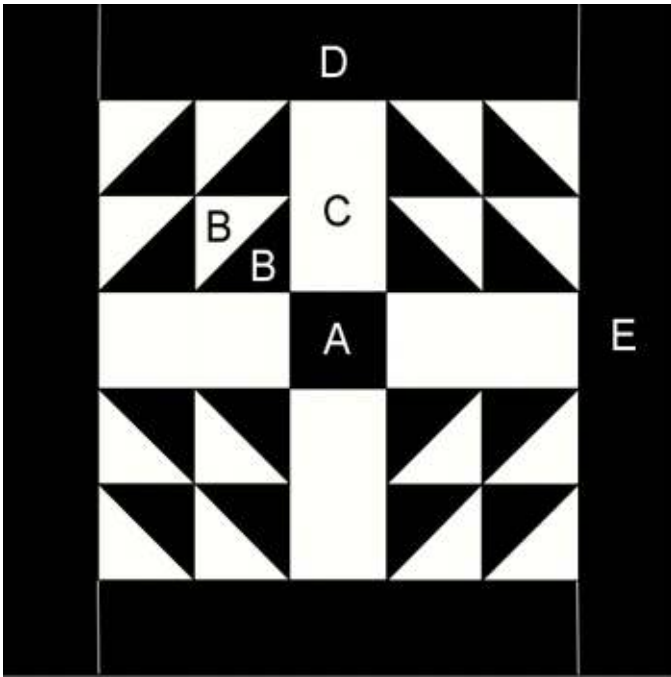


TOMPKINS COUNTY QUILTERS GUILD LOGO "1974"

FLYING GEESE



Cut:

White fabric & Dark blue fabric (B): 1 strip each
2 7/8" X 24"

Then cut strips into eight 2 7/8" squares.

Cut squares in half to form 16 triangles.*

*Alternatively, put a dark and white square right sides together. Use a pencil to draw a line from corner to corner on the white fabric. Sew a scant 1/4" seam on either side of the line. Cut apart on the pencil line.

Dark blue fabric (A): 1 square 2 1/2" X 2 1/2".

White fabric (C): 1 strip 2 1/2" X 18". Cut into 4 rectangles 2 1/2" X 4 1/2".

Dark blue fabric (D): two rectangles 2 1/2" X 10 1/2".

Dark blue fabric (E): two rectangles 2 1/2" X 14 1/2".

Block should be 14 1/2" X 14 1/2" unfinished.

**Press seams to the dark side to avoid shadows and seams where members will sign.

1. Sew 16 half square triangle squares (B). Square up the squares to 2 1/2".
2. Sew four squares together to form a unit. Follow the diagram above to sew pattern in correct direction.
3. Sew white strip (C) between two block units. Repeat with other two block units.
4. Sew small dark block (A) to the remaining two white strips (C) to form center strip.
5. Sew block units to each side of center strip.
6. Add outer borders (D) to top and bottom of block.
7. Add outer borders (E) to both sides of block.
