

Guild Scholarship Guidelines

To request a scholarship, an active Guild member should briefly state in writing or by e-mail the circumstances necessitating financial assistance. The request is reviewed by two members of the Scholarship Committee. Every effort is made to keep the request confidential. Once a decision is made, the guild member will be notified of the decision. If a scholarship is granted, a committee member will notify the Treasurer who will transfer approved funds to the Trips and Travel contact who is organizing the retreat, trip, or workshop.

A scholarship will cover 1/2 the cost of the Casowasco Retreat, the full cost for attending the Quilting-by-the-Lake day trip, and the full cost for a one or two day guild-sponsored workshop. To reserve a place at a Casowasco retreat, the guild member must submit a check for their half of the cost of the retreat prior to the sign-up deadline for members.

Guild members are eligible to request a scholarship twice in a five-year period; once for a Casowasco Retreat and once for a Guild workshop. They may not apply for both types of scholarship in the same year. One scholarship can be awarded by the Guild for each event.
